PARKING

Boat parking launching and Crane Launching is at Okahu Bay 18 Tamaki Drive. We will be launching from the Landing – Dry Stack. Please do not use the public ramp we have been asked to keep this clear for the public use.

NO TENTS OR MARQUEES

There is a Liquor Ban in the area, so we have hired the use of the Royal Akarana Yacht Club which is right beside the trailer and boat parking. This facility is open from 8am for breakfast - everyone is very welcome as they have full bar facilities, café and food available during the day.

RACE DAY

Race HQ is based on the hard stack in the Landing right next to the trailer parking so please refer to attached map. The race bus will be just inside the barrier entrance.

LAUNCHING OF BOATS

Launching of the big boats will be by Crane beside the ramp and inside the Landing dry stack for wet launching. Plenty of ramp area for launching. Plenty of Pontoons to raft upon - please clear as quickly as possible as this is also a public ramp.

The Royal Akarana Yacht Club will have their facilities open all day we will have the prize giving at 5:00 pm. A get together in the clubrooms for drinks and food after the race.
