The Shark bar will be available for use at these times:

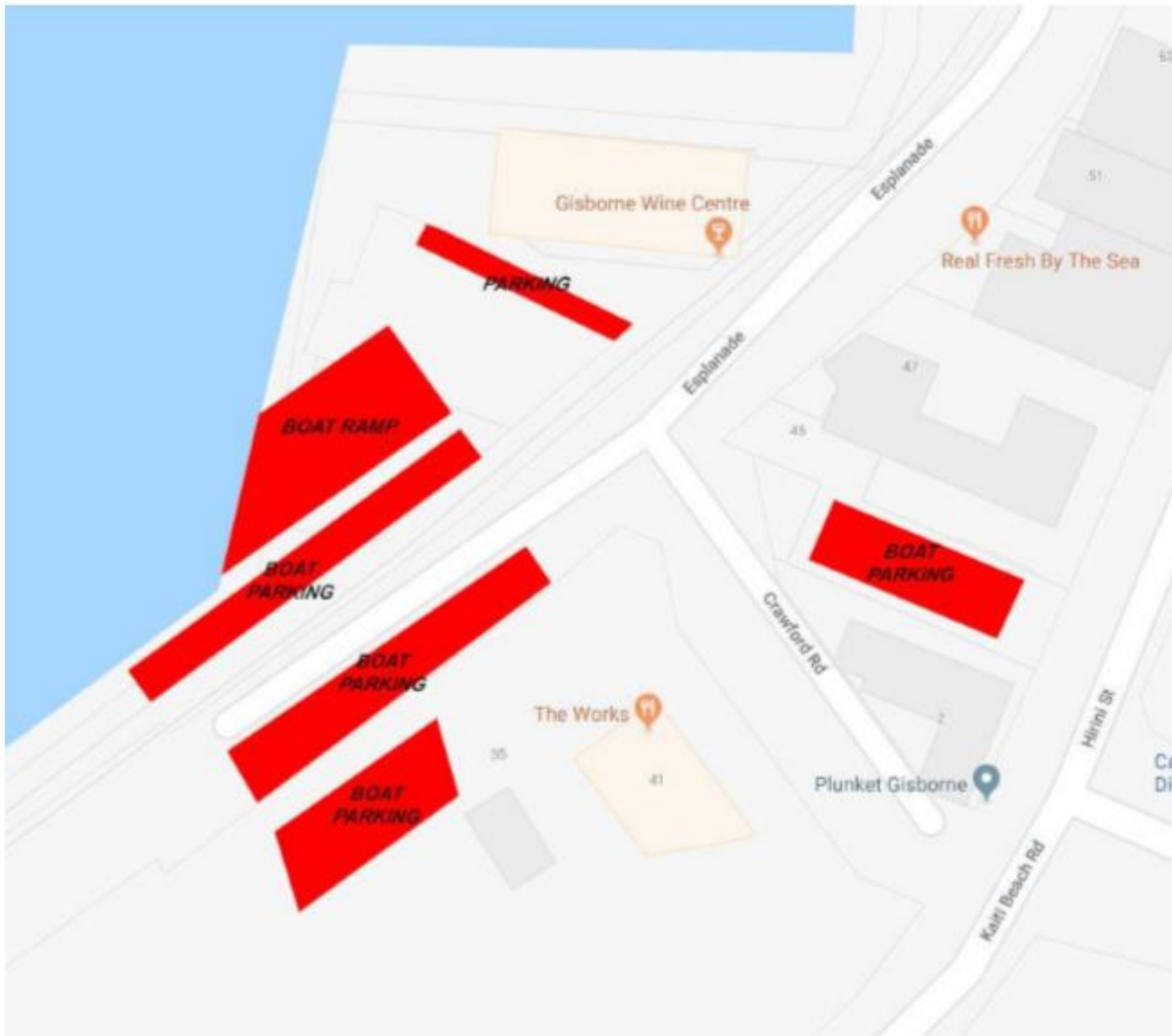
Friday 12th February available from 5pm, Drinks and meals available from 6pm.

This is now a multipurpose area please be courteous to other users.



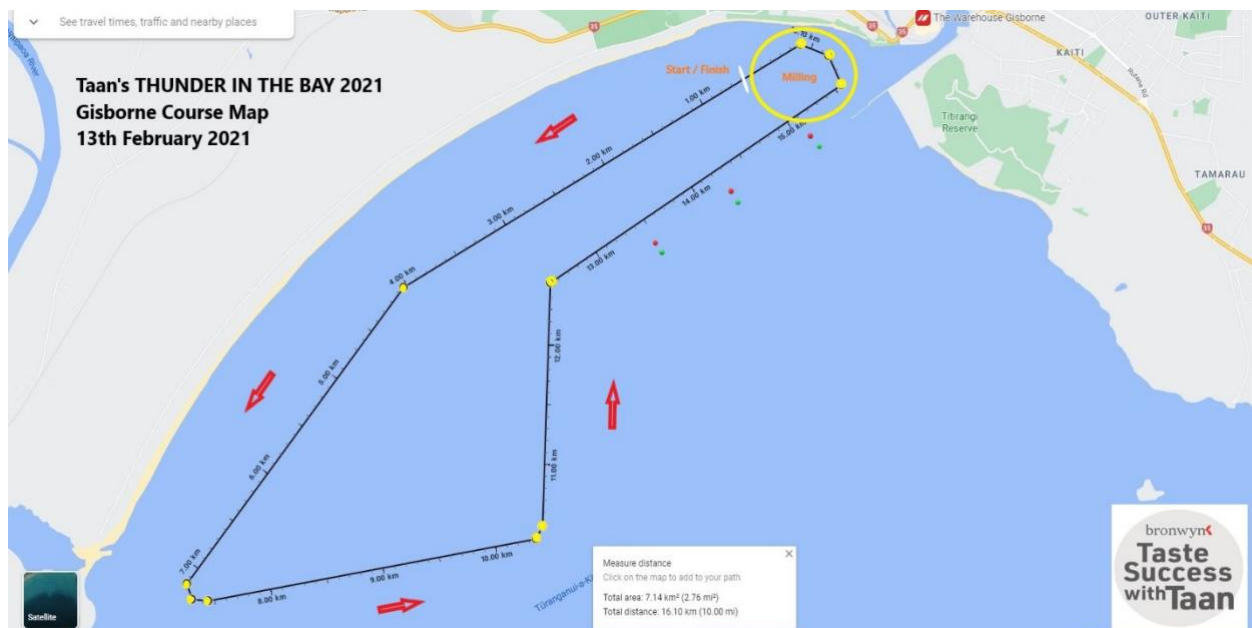
SET UP OF TEAM TENTS 13th & 14th February from 7am onwards

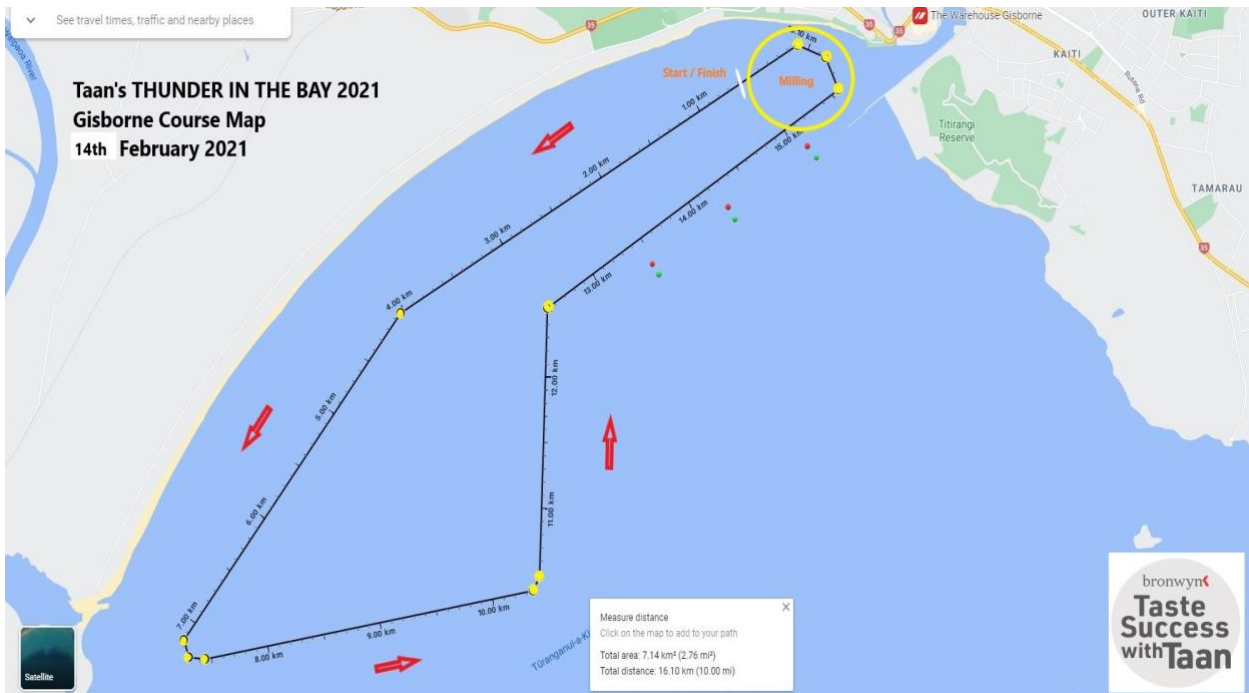
